All ASU baccalaureate students must complete one course with an (H) designation.

Cultural Diversity in the United States (C)

All ASU baccalaureate students must complete one course with a (C) designation.

Global Awareness (G)

All ASU baccalaureate students must complete one course with a (G) designation.
